- PLAINLY HAD A MAJOR IMPACT ON THE 2018
   ELECTIONS AND THE DIRECTIONS THE PARTIES TAKE;
   WE JUST DON'T KNOW YET WHAT THAT IMPACT WAS

# HIGHLIGHT 3: The Consequences of "Wave" Elections


- WAVE ELECTIONS ARE LIKELY TO INCREASE RATHER THAN REDUCE PARTISANSHIP, POLARIZATION AND GRIDLOCK BECAUSE
  - THE DAMAGE FALLS DISPROPORTIONALLY ON MODERATES
    - THEIR DISTRICTS ARE CLOSELY DIVIDED AND THEREFORE EASIER TO FLIP
  - THE HARD LEFT AND THE HARD RIGHT ARE MOSTLY INSULATED FROM THE CARNAGE

## HIGHLIGHT 4: Party Loyalty

AMERICANS ARE STEADILY DISSOCIATING THEMSELVES FROM THE TWO MAJOR PARTIES

MORE NOW SELF-IDENTIFY AS INDEPENDENTS THAN AS REPUBLICANS OR DEMOCRATS

### WHY HAS PARTY ALLEGIANCE DECLINED SO MUCH?

1. THE PARTIES HAVEN'T DELIVERED ON THEIR MANY PROMISES TO DELIVER FOR "THE MIDDLE CLASS" OR "WORKING FAMILIES"

#### **AN EXAMPLE: JOBS**

- EVERY ELECTION BOTH PARTIES' LEADERSHIPS PROMISE TO CREATE HIGH-PAYING, CAREER-LADDER JOBS
- BUT THEIR ACTUAL AGENDAS HAVE NOTHING TO DO WITH JOBS AND MAY EVEN FRUSTRATE JOB CREATION

#### A CASE IN POINT

 OCT. 2018: NANCY PELOSI, AT THE HARVARD INSTITUTE OF POLITICS, "LAID OUT A POLICY AGENDA SHOULD DEMOCRATS WIN POWER THAT WOULD **BEGIN WITH A CAMPAIGN-FINANCE-OVERHAUL PACKAGE BUT ALSO** INCLUDE MEASURES TO LOWER **HEALTH-CARE AND PRESCRIPTION** DRUG COSTS, CHANGE THE WAY THE HOUSE

#### A CASE IN POINT (CONT'D)

OPERATES AND OFFER LEGAL STATUS TO THE YOUNG UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANTS KNOWN AS 'DREAMERS.'

 AS REGARDS THE MUELLER INVESTIGATION INTO POSSIBLE COLLUSION, "GETTING THE FACTS AND THE TRUTH, AND WHERE THEY LEAD US, THAT'S WHAT WE HAVE TO DO"

### WHY HAS PARTY ALLEGIANCE DECLINED SO MUCH?

2. THE AMERICAN DREAM SEEMS TO BE INCREASINGLY OUT OF REACH BUT GOVERNMENT SEEMS OBLIVIOUS TO THAT PROBLEM

#### BYE, BYE, MISS AMERICAN DREAM

- THE AMERICAN DREAM REQUIRES BEING ABLE TO SAVE FOR THE FUTURE
- 46% OF AMERICAN ADULTS CANNOT MEET A \$400 EMERGENCY EXPENSE WITHOUT BORROWING OR SELLING SOMETHING THEY OWN
- ONE QUARTER OF ADULTS CANNOT PAY THEIR MONTHLY BILLS IN FULL

#### **BOTH PARTIES HAVE BEEN GUILTY**

- CAROL, AN AFRICAN-AMERICAN WORKING-CLASS VOTER IN CENTRAL OHIO, WAS ASKED WHAT DIFFERENCE SHE SAW IN HER ECONOMIC WELL-BEING WHEN (A) DEMS WERE IN POWER OR (B) REPS WERE IN POWER: SHE REPLIED, "DOES IT EVEN MATTER?"
